SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES TO ACCOUNT

Significant Accounting Policies

1 Basis of Accounting

The accounts of JUDO FEDERATION OF INDIA) have been prepared on accrual basis, in accounting with the generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP).

2 Revenue Recognition

Income on account of monthly fees has been accounted on accrual basis and expenses have been booked on accrual basis in the same financial year.

3 Fixed Assets and depreciation

Fixed Assets are stated at historical cost less depreciation. JFI doesn't have any other assets other than those appearing in the Balance Sheet as on 31st March, 2025.

4 Notes to Accounts

- One time charge fees has been accounted for as part of the corpus fund of JUDO FEDERATION OF INDIA. As regard of the membership fees has been booked on accrual basis.
- 2. JFI is registered under Society Registration Act XXI of 1860. The main objectives of the Federation are to encourage and promote judo and allied arts and sports in India to provide foster and maintain relations with and between National and International Organizations, Federation Association and to hold different type of National Championship and such other tournaments and to affiliate State Judo Association.



OBSERVATION SHEET

- 1. JFI have maintained proper Books of Accounts.
- 2. JFI has fully adhered to the prescribed accounting Standards.
- 3. Grants and Donations received by the society were properly tracked and accounted for.

SUGGESTION / RECOMMENDATION

- 1. The Amount retained in the saving account is to be invested as fixed deposits from which some return can be derived.
- 2. It was observed that certain receivables have been outstanding in the books of accounts for more than two years. Upon review, there appears to be low certainty of recovery of these dues, and no significant follow-up or confirmation has been noted. Management should evaluate the recoverability of all long outstanding dues and consider writing off or making appropriate provisions for balances where the possibility of recovery is remote, in line with applicable accounting standards and prudent accounting practices.
- 3. As per the actuarial valuation report, the gratuity liability of the company amounts to ₹40,43,891. However, no irrevocable trust has been established to fund this liability, as required under the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961 and supported by Accounting Standard 15 (AS 15) or Ind AS 19, as applicable.

JFI should promptly embark on the process of establishing an irrevocable Gratuity Trust, appointing a minimum of two trustees, and ensuring that a contribution commensurate with the actuarially determined liability is made and judiciously invested in accordance with Rule 101 of the Income Tax Rules, 1962. This will guarantee statutory compliance and foster long-term financial sustainability.

Note No. 14 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

14.1 Background of the entity

The Judo Federation of India was formed in 1965. It is the national governing body for the sport of Judo in India. The Federation organizes national tournaments, select athelets for international competitions, and provide training and resources for Judo Practitioners.

JFI works in affiliation with the International Judo Federation (IJF) and the Judo Union of Asia (JUA) to ensure that Indian athletes can compete at the highest levels internationally. The federation also collaborates with various state judo associations to promote the sport across different regions of India.

14.2 Significant Accounting Policies

(I) Basis of preparation

- a) The financial statements have been prepared in accordance under the historical cost convention, in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles.
- b) Accounts are maintained on mercantile Basis. All incomes and expenses accounted for on Accrual/Due Basis.

(II) Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are stated at their written down value. Fixed assets are disclosed at net written down value at the beginning and end of the of the accounting year showing additions, disposal, other movements and depreciation for the Year. Addition during the year includes inward freight, duties taxes, and expenses incidental to acquisitions and installations.

(III) Depreciation

Depreciation has been provided on written down value basis, as per the rate prescribed in Income Tax Act, 1961.

(IV) Employee Benefit

Provision for Gratuity has been accounted for as per the Provision For Gratuity Act, 1972.

(V) Recognition of Entry & Registration

a) Affiliation Fee

Any amount received as affiliation fee (First time) is directly credited to the corpus fund. Subsequent Affiliation Fees received from the State Government/Federation is accounted for as Income.

b) Entry and Registration Fees

Income in respect of Entry and registration fee pertaining to each event is recognized event wise.

(VI) Grants

Grant-in-aid is received on behalf of organizing states/units and the same is disbursed to them. Any amount remaining undisbursed shown in the Balance sheet as Outstanding Liabilities.

Expenditure incurred over and above the amount received from the Grant in respect of International events is charged to revenue.
