Also please note that the probable for the 2018 Asian Games will also be selected from the Best 4 players from each weight category of the said championships, subject to clearance of their physical fitness test. Changing of weight category will not be allowed, and if the player wishes to do so, he/she will not be considered as part of the best 4 players.

The FINAL Entry by Name as per the JFI attached format must reach before 5th March 2018. A copy of the General Information and Regulations along with Entry Forms are enclosed. Railway concession voucher will be sent as soon as received from SAI.

COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS
(Senior National Judo Championships -2017-18)

- 1. DATE :** The Senior National Judo Championships 2017-18 for Men & Women will be held from 10th to 13th March 2018.

Tentative Programme :

- 10/03/2018 : Arrival of Technical Officials, Teams, JFI Officials
& Accreditation, Manager's Meeting, Draws and Judogi Control.
- 11/03/2018 : Opening Ceremony & Competitions.
- 12/03/2018 : Competitions & Closing
- 13/03/2018 : Departure of all officials & Teams (before noon)

- 1.1 VENUE :** M. A. Stadium, Jammu, Jammu & Kashmir.

1.2 WEIGHT CATEGORIES :

Men (above 15 years)	Women (above 15 years)
Upto and including 60Kg	Upto and including 48Kg
Over 60Kg upto and including 66Kg	Over 48Kg upto and including 52Kg
Over 66Kg upto and including 73Kg	Over 52Kg upto and including 57Kg
Over 73Kg upto and including 81Kg	Over 57Kg upto and including 63Kg
Over 81Kg upto and including 90Kg	Over 63Kg upto and including 70Kg
Over 90Kg upto and including 100Kg	Over 70Kg upto and including 78Kg

1.3. ELIGIBILITY :

- a] Players must be above 15 Years as on 10th March 2018.
- b] All competitors must participate from their State/Departmental Unit from where they have obtained their Registration to JFI. Only Registered player and officials will be eligible to participate.
- c] A player who is under 18 years will participate at his/her own risk and responsibility and a NO OBJECTION Certificate (NOC) from parents/guardian will be required before he/she is accredited for Championships.

1.4 CONTROL OF ENTRIES OF THE ATHLETES:

The control of entry of the athletes will take place at M.A. Stadium, Jammu on 10th March 2018, during the accreditation. Each head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their Date of Birth like Aadhaar Card/Driving License/Voter ID, any other documents approved by the Government of India, or JFI Registration Card.

1.5 ENTRIES:

- a] Each State/Departmental Units may enter only one player in each of the above weight categories.
- b] Each State/ Departmental Unit is permitted to appoint one Manager and Two Coaches only (one Men & one Women coach). The players and officials will be collectively referred to as the Team. The maximum permissible strength of each team shall be of 17 members (7 +7 + 2 coaches + 1 Manager).
- c] Lodging for the extra members will not be provided.
- d] Team Manager will be responsible for the proper conduct and affairs of the team & will be contacted for all official/unofficial matters.
- e] Final entries by Name must be received by JFI latest by 5th March 2018. After the due date of Final Entry i.e. 5th March 2018 NO ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED. **Substitution is considered only in case of injury.**

1.6 METHODS OF COMPETITION: The Championships will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF New Refereeing Rules.

Matches will be conducted on Knockout cum Double Repechage basis. (Repechage will start from quarter finals onwards.)

1.7 DURATION: MEN :4 (Four) minutes WOMEN : 4(Four) minutes

1.8 WEIGH-IN & JUDO GI CONTROL :

- a] Weighin of the players will be held **a day prior to the competition** by evening, of their event. However, the organisers reserve the right to hold the weighin at any other time, after giving advance notice, thereof to all the Managers.

- b] Contestant in categories must fall strictly within the lower & upper limits of that weight category.
- c] Contestants are advised to come adequately prepared with proper gymnastic under clothing for the weigh-in.
- d] First Judogi control will be done at the time of weigh-in. All players are required to present two Judogis for the first Judogi Control.
- e] Each competitor will be allowed on the weigh-in scale only once during official weigh-in.

1.9 FEMINITY CONTROL: A medical certificate in English/Hindi issued by a qualified Gynaecologist of the player's State/Department, attesting the Sex & Nonpregnancy of the women players, must be submitted by the Manager during accreditation. Such a certificate must have been issued on or after 20th February 2018 and not before.

1.10. DRAWS : The draws ceremony will be held on 10th March 2018 at 5.00 p.m. A maximum of two delegates from each participating State/Department, may attend the draws ceremony.

1.11 TECHNICAL OFFICIAL :

- a] Qualified Officials will be appointed by the JFI to perform functions like scorekeeping, timekeeping, refereeing & other technical functions.
- b] All Technical Officials must be in uniform as per the stipulations of the JFI Sporting Code (White Shirt, Dark Gray Trousers, Black Shoes & Socks, Badge and Official Tie).
- c] All Technical Officials are required to attend Technical Meetings.

1.12. PRIZES :

- a] Winner in each category will be awarded a Gold plated Medal and Merit Certificate.
- b] Runner-up in each weight category will be awarded a Silver plated Medal and Merit Certificate.
- c] The Third place winner (2 third places) will be awarded a Bronze plated Medal and Merit Certificate.
- d] No Protests shall be entertained. The decision of the Jury appointed by JFI Technical Council will be final.

1.13 Lodging & Boarding: Organisers will arrange lodging & boarding (max. 17 person per team) from 10th March 2018 (from lunch) to 13th March 2018 (till noon) only & not thereafter. However, an amount of Rs.150/- (Rupees One Hundred and Fifty only) will be charged by the organising Committee towards the Food expenses per person per day for 3 days, subject to clearance & recognition from MYAS.

1.14 Transportation : Transport will be provided free of cost to all the participants from Railway Station (Jammu-Tawi) to the place of accommodation and from place of accommodation to venue and back.

All the participants are requested to bring their own bedding.

1.15 Arrival :All teams must reach Jammu – Tawi railway station on 10th March 2018. Therefore, all the participating States/Department Units are requested to inform their Travel Schedule well in advance to enable the organisers to receive them, on arrival.

1.16 DEPARTURE :Return tickets must be booked by the teams so as to leave Jammu on 13th March 2018 before noon.

1.17 DISQUALIFICATION :

- a] In case any player is disqualified by any reason, his/her expenses will not be borne by the organisers, and Certificate of Participation will not be issued.
- b] In case of any damage caused by any team member, the cost will have to be paid by the Manager before the team departs.
- c] Any player and/or official and/or team who by word, action or deed disrupts and or/interrupts the smooth and normal conduct of the Championships on or off the mat, will be liable for immediate disqualification.

1.18 INSURANCE: Each State Association/Department Unit must assure all responsibility of accident/illness/miss-happening etc. and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials during their stay in Jammu & Journey. The JFI & Organisers do not accept any responsibility in this regard. It is requested to make necessary insurance coverage for your team.

1.19 Judogi Control : Judogi control will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. The Judogi should be as per the approved norms.

1.20 ANTI -DOPING :Doping test will be carried out in accordance with the rules by NADA.

2.1 FEE :

a] **Team Entry Fee :** A Demand Draft of Rs. 2500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred only) drawn in favour of 'JUDO FEDERATION OF INDIA' payable at Delhi.

b] **Registration Fee :** All un-registered players/officials must pay a sum of Rs.200/=(Rupees Two Hundred only) towards the JFI registration fee.

C] **Inscription Fee :** Rs. 200/-(Rupees Two hundred only) for each player and official, to participate in the event.

2.2 ACCREDITATION :

- a] Accreditation will be held on 10th March 2018 at M. A. Stadium, Jammu.
- b] It is mandatory for all Managers to submit the necessary documents of all the team members during accreditation.

2.3 FLAG HOSTING & MARCH PAST: Competitors & officials of each state/Dept. as well as the Technical Officials are required to take part in the Flag hosting & March Past during the Opening ceremony. They should be dressed properly (Tracksuits or Judogis only)
