1] ORGANIZER	:	JUDO FEDEATION OF INDIA
2] DATE	:	22 nd to 25 th June 2022
3] VENUE	:	MAIN ARENA, K.D. JHADAV INDOOR STADIUM, I.G. STADIUM COMPLEX, NEW DELHI

4] WEIGH-IN:

- (a) The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the International Judo federation (IJF) Guiding document Sports Organisation Rules (SOR).
- (b) The athlete's official weigh in will be scheduled the day before the competition.

<u>Cadet</u>: Unofficial weigh-in: 5.p.m. to 6.p.m. (the day before) Official weigh-in: 6.p.m. to 8.p.m (the day before)

<u>Junior</u>: Unofficial weigh-in: 5.p.m to 6.p.m (the day before) Official weigh-in: 6.p.m to 8.p.m (the day before)

(c) The weigh-in will be held at MAIN ARENA, K.D. JHADAV INDOOR STADIUM,

(d) Random weigh- in will open one hour before the start of the competition each day until approximately 30 minutes before the athlete's first contest at the latest.The athletes must bring their accreditation for identification. The weight of the athlete cannot

be more than 5 % higher than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

5] ELIGIBILITY: The athletes/Judoka must be of the same State / Unit for which they have been entered for the competition.

6] SELECTION CRITERIA:

1] The First place holder / Winner of each weight Category will be selected for the Asian Cadet & Junior Judo Championships 2022, Thailand, subject to the following mandatory requirements and fitness:

- a] Must have a valid Passport minimum till December 2022
- b] Must pass the Medical & Fitness Test
- c] Must follow all the rules and regulations of Covid -19 Vaccinations as per the Organisors of the Asian Cadet & Junior Judo Championships 2022
- d] Must complete IJF Registration, procurement of IJF approved backnumbers and Judogies

2] The National Ranking will be placed till 8th position of each weight category.

3] Selection of Teams for the other International events will be on the basis of National Ranking/Trials.

4] Decision of Selection Committee will be treated as Final.

10] CONTESTANTS AGE:

Cadet:

Boys and Girls under 18, age 15, 16 and 17 years (Calendar year–Jan to Dec). (Must be born between 2005, 2006, and 2007)

Junior:

Men and Women under 21, age 15 to 20 years (calendar year). (Must be born between 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007)

Reminders: For contestants under 18 years old, the entry form must be countersigned by parent / guardian.

11] ENTRY & REGISTRATION FEE

A] ENTRY FEES: Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) per athlete/player

B] JFI REGISTRATION FEE: Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred only) per participant

12] DRAW: The draw will be held on 22nd June 2022 for Cadet (Boys & Girls) on 23rd June 2022 for Junior (Women) & on 24th June 2022 for Junior MEN

13] REFEREES: ITO and NTO referees will be nominated by the JFI

14] MANDATORY DOCUMENT /IDENTITY:

A] ALL THE JUDO PLAYERS MUST HAVE PASSPORT VAILD MINIMUM TILL DECEMBER 2022

B] Contestants are required to show his / her original passport and AADHAR card/School leaving Certificate / Bonafede birth certificate to confirm their identity.

15] JUDOGI: In accordance with the IJF (SOR) regulations.

16] ACCREDITATION:

The Accreditation will be held at the MAIN ARENA, K.D. JHADAV INDOOR STADIUM as per the schedule.

17] METHODS OF COMPETITION:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF (SOR) and IJF Refereeing Rules. Competition systems according to number of participants:

- 6 and more entries : Knok-out cum quarter final repechage
- 3,4,5 entries : round robin (all play all)

• 2 entries : better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

18] BOARDING, LODGING, TRANSPORTATION: No allowance will be paid towards the boarding, lodging and transportation. All charges will be at own cost of participants

19] INSURANCE: All State Bodies/Govt./Clubs/Academies/Parents must assume all responsibilities for accident and health insurance as well as civil liability for their contestants and officials. Judo Federation of India will not be responsible of any claim of illness, injury, and death and Covid-19 case of any participants/officials whatsoever.

20] ANTI-DOPING CONTROL:

The Anti-Doping Control will be carried out by NADA in accordance with the IJF Anti-Doping Rules and Sports Organization Rules.

21] DISQUALIFICATION :

a] Any player who by word, action or deed disrupts and or/interrupts the smooth and normal conduct of the Trails on or off the mat, will be liable for immediate disqualification.

B] Any player/official who do not follow the Covid-19 protocol as per the SOP of MYAS will be disqualified with immediate effect.

22] The Judo player, those who will be selected in the Indian Judo teams, it is necessary to submit/obtain the following :

REGISTRATION WITH INTERNATIONAL JUDO FEDERATION, JUDO DRESS & BACKNUMBER FOR JUDO DRESS:

All the player MUST complete / obtain the following soon after their selection in the Indian Judo Team:

- Submit the required documents visa and entry, like Passport, Photograph 4 Nos. (35mm x 45mm size, with white background, 70-80% clause-up), Individual Bank Statements for last 6 months, NOC from School/College etc.
- IJF Registration : This can be done only through JFI Office, for which the documents required are, valid passport, photograph, and Credit/Debit Card to make online payment, approximate EURO-67=00 per person. This registration is mandatory to submit online Entry and is valid from two years.
- Each player must have Two pair of IJF APPROVED Judo Dress (1 white & 1 Blue), which can purchase online. List of approved companies will get from URL <u>https://www.ijf.org/supplier-list</u>
- Each player must have also minimum Two IJF BACKNUMBER for placing on the Judo Dress (1 white & 1 Blue), which be purchased online. There are two companies are approved by the IJF, and their URL is :
