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5] CONTESTANTS AGE (Calendar year – January ~ December):

A] Cadets: Boys and Girls above 15 years and under 18 years (must be born between 2006, 2007 and 2008)

B] <u>Undertaking</u>: It is the responsibility of the State Associations/UTs that the secondary entry must be countersigned by Parent/guardian of players who are under 18years, and to submit with the Final Entry during accreditation.

6] CONTEST RULES: The Championships will be held on the basis of JFI/IJF Contest Rules and Regulations and the Sporting Code.

7] PARTICIPATIONS:

- A] An athlete can participate from each State/UT in one weight category only.
- B] Only Registered players and officials will be allowed to participate.
- **8] ELIGIBILITY:** All the players must fall in the respective age and weight Group, and as per the other rules and regulations mentioned.

9] ENTRIES:

- a. Final Entry by Name must be received by JFI office and the Organizing Committee on or before 15th June 2023 on JFI email: jfiindia@gmail.com & IIS Email: saurabh.bharwal@inspireinstituteofsport.com NO Entry will be accepted after the deadline.
- b. Hard copy of the final entries by name must be TYPED and submitted in DUPLICATE in the enclosed format during accreditation.
- c. Final Entry form must be signed and stamped by the President/Secretary of the State/UT Judo Association.
- d. NO change or re-arrangement of players will be allowed after the entries are submitted until and unless injury/medical ground. A player who fails to qualify at any stage will be disqualified and no one else can be substituted in his/her place.
- e. Xerox copy of the age proof of EACH competitor must be attached along with the entry form.
- f. Players and Officials must bring their latest Two passport size photographs.

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10] WEIGH-IN:

- a. A player must fit into his/her weight category and cannot play in a higher or lower weight category. Each competitor shall be allowed upon the scales only once during the official weigh- in. If the player weights above or below the prescribed limits of that particular weight category, he/she shall be disqualified and certificate of participation will not be issued.
- b. No tolerance will be allowed either above or below the weight category.
- c. Weigh-in will be conducted one day prior on which matches in that category will/are to be played.

d. Weigh-in schedule: Un-official weigh in: Every day from 5.00.pm.to 6.00 pm.

Official weigh-in : Every day from 6.00 pm.to 7.00 pm.

DURATION : All matches for Boys & Girls will be as under :

12] CONDUCT OF MATCHES:

a. Matches will be conducted on knock out cum double repechage (repechage will start quarterfinal onwards).

b. Rules pertaining to Arm Locks & Choke Locks.

Cadets: Arm locks are allowed.

Choke Locks are allowed. However, if a player gets unconscious in a bout, then the player cannot play the subsequent bout.

- AGE PROOF: The following Three (3) Original documents must be brought with the team for acceptance as proof of age:
 - a] Original Birth Certificate issued by the local Municipal Corporation/Panchayat Board or equivalent government authority/chief medical officer who is a competent authority. The DOB Certificate must be issued minimum of THREE (3) year before.
 - Original Certificate issued by the Principal/Headmaster of the School, mentioning Date of Birth, Father's Name and Class, where the boy/girl is studying, on official letter head of the School, with Photograph of the student and Affiliation Number issued by State Board/CBSE/Education Deptt., with place of issue, duly attested. The proper address, telephone nos., fax number email ld of the School must be mentioned, in the letter head.
 - c] Original Aadhar Card issued by the Government Of India.





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Copies of the above documents must be attached with the Final Entry Forms.

14] Age Verification Test Report:

The AVT Reports must be produced by the athlete on demand of the JFI Officials.

Measures against Age Fraud: As per the Government Circular Ltr. No. F-32- 18/2009-SP-III, Dated 25/11/2009, measures against age fraud in sports, JFI have the right to take medical examination of an athlete whenever any doubt arise with regard the age of an athlete on account of his/her physical appearance, receipt of any compliant or any other valid ground. In case of such examination found positive, JFI can take the necessary action as per the clauses of Disqualification.

16] TEAM OFFICIALS:

- a. Maximum number of Officials permitted is One Manager and Two Coaches. No extra member allowed.
- b. Only JFI nominated Referees will be allowed. No Team Referees allowed.

17] DISQUALIFICATION:

- a] In case any player fail to submit the Original documents mentioned in the above Age Proof column, he/she will be disqualified.
- b] In case of any player found over-age, he/she will be disqualified.
- c] In case Four (4) or more players found over-age, the whole team will be disqualified, and face the disciplinary action by the JFI.
- d] In case any player is disqualified at any reason, his/her expenses will not be borne by the Organizers.
- e] In case of any damage caused by any team member, the cost will have to be paid by the Manager before the team departs.
- f] Any player and/or official and/or team who by word, action or deed disrupts and or/interrupts the smooth and normal conduct of the Championships on or off the mat, will be liable for immediate disqualification.
- g] In case any team member will NOT for follow the COVID-19 Protocol/SOP he/she will be disqualified immediately.
- h] NO Participation Certificate issued to any DISQUALIFED athlete/official.

18] Judogi Control:

Each player must bring 2 Judogies (one Blue and one White) for participating in the Championships. The Judogi should be as per the IJF and JFI approved norms.





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Judogi Control will be operated with a Judogi measurement scale prior to the fight. If any athlete/player disqualify his Judogi, he/she will be disqualified from the bout.

19] Insurance:

Each State Association/UT must assure all responsibility of accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials during their stay at IIS and the journey. The Judo Federation of India or the Organisors Inspire Institute of Sports will not accept any responsibility in this regard. It is requested to make necessary insurance coverage for your team.

20] JFI Registration, Inscription, Entry Fee:

a. Inscription Fee: : Players/ officials (per person) : Rs.200.00

b. JFI Registration Fee : Players/ Officials (Per person) : Rs.200.00

c. Team entry fee : Each State/UT : Rs. 2500.00

The payments must be paid by Demand Draft or by the Cheque of the respective State Associations/UT. The DD/Chq. must be drawn in favour of **Judo Federation of India**, **payable at Delhi**. Payment in Cash will not be accepted.

21] Boarding & Lodging:

- a. Free Boarding & Lodging will be provided by the Organizer (IIS) for all accredited participants, from 5th July 2023 (from Noon) to 10th July 2023 (till Noon), however all the States/UTs are requested to convey your Team's Travel schedule to the IIS latest by 20th June 2023 to ensure the local transportation.
- b. The Boarding & Lodging will be arranged for the Team Members ONLY. No extra accommodation also be provided to other than the team members.
- c. Any damage caused by any player/official to any accommodated room/premises the player/official the expenses ,shall be borne by the State Team Manager / Coach or the State Association only and the JFI/IIS shall not take responsibility or guarantee for any such incident in or out of the accommodation place/ stadium premises.

22] Anti-Doping:

Doping test will be carried out in accordance with the rules, by the respective authorities





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23] March Past:

All Competitors & Officials of each State as well as the Technical Officials are required to take part in the March Past and during the Opening ceremony. They should be dressed properly (either in tracksuit or Judogies only)

Dress Code for Coaches: All the Team Coaches must be followed the Dress Code as per the IJF Rules.

25] Transportation:

<u>By Train</u>: The Organizers will provide free transportation from the Toranagallu Railway/Bus Station on arrival and back for the departure, however the Travel Schedule must be informed to the Organizers by 25th June 2023, failing which the Organizers will not be responsible for the same.

The Travel Plan may followed as per the below directions to reach the destination:
