

Order of Returning Officer to the objections to the Nomination list in Form 3

The undersigned, acting in the capacity of Returning Officer, received the objections filed and, after due consideration of the same, hereby disposed of as following:

1. Objections against Mukesh Kumar bearing electoral No (31). It is pointed out that at the time of finalizing the electoral roll the allegations against the Mukesh Kumar have been duly considered and disposed of vide order dated 15.05.2026 and that order attained the finality therefore same need not to reopen at this stage.
2. Objections against Sh. K N Tripathi bearing electoral No (25). The allegations against Sh. KN Tripathi have been already considered and disposed of vide order dated 15.05.2026 therefore same order attained finality.
3. Objections received to the effect that a candidate must have the domicile of the concern state representing, in this regard relevant section 4 (2) of the act which is sufficient answer to objections.
4. That the nomination form of Ms. Renu Kalja bearing Electoral Roll No. 20 was proposed by Sh. Ronnie Rosanga Varte bearing Electoral Roll No. 39. Accordingly, the representation submitted in this regard is allowed since it is a clerical mistake, therefore the Electoral Roll No. (40) mentioned in the Nomination form shall be read and corrected as (39).
5. During the scrutiny of nominations received for the post of joint secretary the undersigned found that Sh. Mahipal Grewal has proposed the names of Sh. Prikshit Tiwary bearing electoral no. (26), Sh. Rajpal Chauhan bearing electoral no. (11) and Sh. Vinod Solanki bearing electoral no. (13) as per the rule 5 *"No person shall be entitled to propose or second more than one candidate for the same post. In the event of multiple nominations, only the first valid nomination received by the Electoral Officer shall be considered, and subsequent nominations shall be treated as invalid, in accordance with schedule II, clause 6(iii)"*. In the light of this the nomination of Sh. Rajpal Chauhan, being the first valid nomination received, is accepted, whereas the nominations of Sh. Prikshit Tiwary and Sh. Vinod Solanki are treated as invalid.
6. It is hereby notified that one of the candidates, Sh. Man Mohan Jaiswal bearing Electoral Roll No. (47), submitted two nomination forms for the same post. In the first nomination form, the proposer is Sh. Rajpal Chauhan bearing Electoral Roll No. 11 and the seconder is Sh. Vikramsinh Pundalikrao Kadampatil bearing Electoral Roll No. 28.

In the second nomination form, the proposer is Ms. Devishree Kadampatil bearing Electoral Roll No. (27) and the seconder is Sh. Bijoy Koijam bearing Electoral Roll No. (35). It has been observed that Ms. Devishree Kadampatil had already proposed the nomination of Sh. Mahipal Grewal. As per Rule 5, no person shall be entitled to propose or second more than one candidate for the same post. Therefore, the first nomination form submitted by Sh. Man Mohan Jaiswal is accepted, whereas the second nomination form shall be treated as invalid.

7. Objections also received against Sh. Virender Vashist bearing electoral no. (14) and the undersigned sought a written reply from him. The reply given by him is self explanatory and he justified his candidature so objection filed against him is declined.
8. It is further notified that the previously communicated address for withdrawal of nominations stands changed. The revised address for withdrawal of nominations, as published on the JFI website, is **F-14, Gali No. 12, Parwana Road, Opposite HDFC Bank, Delhi – 110051**. All concerned candidates are requested to take note of the same.
