Sub. : Open Selection Trials for selecting Indian Judo Teams (Men & Women) on 7th and 8th July 2019 at National Bal Bhawan, Kotla Road, New Delhi, for the forthcoming Commonwealth Judo Championships and Asian Open Taipei 2019.

Sir/Madam,

I would like to inform you that JFI is conducting Open Selection Trials on 7th and 8th July 2019 at National Bal Bhawan, Kotla Road, New Delhi; for selecting Indian Judo Teams (Men & Women) for the following forthcoming events:

- a] Asian Open – Taipei : 1 – 5 August 2019 (selection for Senior Men & Women only)
b] Commonwealth Judo Championships , from 25th to 29th September 2019 (selection for Pre-Cadet Boys & Girls, Senior Men & Women, and 2 weight categories of Junior i.e. -44Kg Women and -55Kg of Men)

2] **Weight Category (PRE-CADET – Boys & Girls):**

Girls : -36kg; -40kg; -44kg; -48kg; -52kg; -57kg; -63Kg, -70Kg, +70Kg
Boys : -34kg; -38kg; -42kg; -46kg; -50kg; -55kg; -60kg; -66kg, -73kg, +73Kg

Age limit : Competitors must be born in the years 2005-2006.

3] **Weight Category (JUNIOR – Men & Women):**

Women: Below -44Kg,
Men: Below -55Kg,

Age limit : Competitors must be born in the years 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 or 2004.

4] **Weight Category (SENIOR – Men & Women):**

WOMEN: Below -44Kg, 48Kg, -52Kg, -57Kg, -63Kg, -70Kg, -78Kg, +78Kg.
MEN: Below -55Kg, 60Kg, -66Kg, -73Kg, -81Kg., -90Kg, -100Kg, +100Kg.

Age limit Competitors must be born in the year 1999 or before.

5] Duration of Contest for Cadet, Junior and Senior

Men : 4(Four) Minutes
Women : 4 (Four) Minutes

6] Eligibility:

- All Judokas must be a registered in Judo Federation of India.
- All Judokas must have **valid Passport with a minimum validity of 6 months** (till March 2020)
- All Judokas must pay Entry Fee for Pre-Cadet/Junior Rs.300/- and for Seniors Rs.500/-.
- All Pre-Cadet and Junior players **MUST BRING THEIR AGE VERIFICATION CERTIFICATE (AVT Report) . Without AVT Report, No player will be allowed to participate in the Trials.**
- In case of his/her selection for National Camp, the following are to be obtained, by the selected player:
- Obtain at-least Two pair of IJF APPROVED Judo Dress (1 White & 1 Blue)
- Obtain IJF Back Number for minimum Two Judo Dresses.
- A player can participate in One Weight Category, only. More than one player can participate in each weight category from one State/Unit. No limit for participation of players in each category.
- Participation is allowed only through affiliated State Associations / Departmental Units.
- The player must be ready to participate at Own Cost in case of Govt. not approved.

7] Selection Criteria:

- A] The winner of the trials of Senior Men & Women will be selected for the Asian Open Taipei 2019 (except 44kg and 55Kg) & all 16 categories for Commonwealth Judo Championships – 2019
- B] The winner of the trials of Pre-Cadet and Junior will be selected for the Commonwealth Judo Championships 2019 – UK
- C] The final selection of players is subject to pass the Physical Efficiency Test.
- D] All the winners **MUST** go for the Ant-Dope Test before the departure for the above events
- E] The decision of the Selection Committee will be treated as Final
- F] Those who will fail in AVT or ignoring to submit Urine sample to NADA Officials / Not obtain submission of sample to NADA prior to the Departure will be removed from the position won, and also punishable as per the rules of JFI/NADA.

8] **All the 1st/2nd/3rd position holders of trials will be going for dope test by NADA & random test may be taken by NADA officials of any player. AVT is mandatory**

9] The participants will participate at his/her own risk. Judo Federation of India is not responsible for any kind of injury/accidents during the trials.

10] All the expenses (i.e. Boarding, Lodging, Traveling etc.) are to be borne by the individual/State Association/Departmental Units, to participate in the selection trials.

11] The decision of the Selection Committee will be treated as final.

12] Anti Dope Test will be carried soon after the bouts/trials, all players must co-operate with the NADA Officials.

Please clearly explain the above conditions to your player/s before sending him/her/them to participate in the trials.
