2. ACTC 2024 RECOMMENDATIONS

TRIALS OR RANKING COMPETITIONS CAN BE DECIDED BEFORE 31 MARCH TO SHORTLIST ATHLETES. Because calendar year ended on 31 DECEMBER AND OVER AGE PLAYERS CANNOT COMPETE IN THEIR RESPECTIVE AGE GROUPS IF WE SELECT THEM ON THE BASIS OF NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS, ENDED BEFORE 31 DECEMBER, 2023.

"There is always budget problem during finalisation of ACTC meeting. They limit judo budget and cut many events by giving no performance reasons. It's going to happen again therefore JFI should force SAI to approve all events of junior and cadets. If they want to cut events they can cut senior's budget after Olympics".

Because there is no satisfactory performance at senior level. We have to focus on medal prospect weight categories especially in seniors. Athletes who are continuously failure should not be sent cost to government.

4. TID AND SELECTION

NEW TID/INDUCTION

Experts' visit to different places all over India, especially hilly state, North- East states/Trials zone-wise/ State-wise (Many won't get chance to come at national level trials/ events)

- Training venues: SAI/IIS/STATE CENTRES
- Coaches: QUALIFIED SAI/ JFI/IJF License holder
- •Target: 2024: Before 31 March 90 (appearing for JFI National diploma in coaching NDIC).
- •Target 2024 onward: Every year 200 JFI NDIC Level-1 COACHES, 50 IJF LEVEL-1
- •SUPPORT STAFF: DOCTOS, PHYSIO THERAPISTS, MASSEURS, S&C EXPERTS, MENTAL TRAINER, VIDEO & DATA ANALYSTS, TOUR MANAGERS etc.

5. COACHES & REFEREES DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

COACHES

JFI going to modify its Black Belt syllabus. Syllabus will have subjects related to coaching like IJF Level-1,2 & 3 (*Already submitted for approval to JFI)

NDIC (National Diploma in coaching).

- ➤ JFI is going to regularize Level-1, Level-2. & Level-3 gradation for coaching). SHO-Dan (1st degree black belt holder would be Level -1 instructor/ Trainer (Already started, first NDIC online theory course is done, practical pending).
- ➤ To clear Level-2 Coach, level-1 instructor has to pass Ni- Dan (2nd degree Black belt, coaching).
- ➤ To clear Level-3 i.e. High performance coach. Coach has to clear 3rd degree Black belt (coaching).
- Coach who clears JFI Level -1 will be eligible to appear in IJF level-1 JFI WILL HAVE PLAN TO SEND MAXIMUM JFI, LEVEL-1 COACHES for IJF LEVEL -1 on merit.
- MINIMUM TWO NATIONAL LEVEL COACHING SEMINAR ARE THE TARGET FROM 2024 ONWARDS. Coaches will attend JUA/IIJF/EU/ International seminars at own cost or at sponsors/ assistance from government/ department/ association.

REFEREES

NDIO National Diploma in Officiatig: Already in process

- Candidates who are clearing JFI (Sho-Dan Refereeing) level- 1 Black belt National Diploma in officiating).
- Candidate has to pass Practical exam/assessment during JFI events.
- According to merit referees are presently being sent to JUA/ IJF events. JFI will conduct Minimum two national seminars in 2024 and onward. JFI will send referees, on merit for international seminars (at own cost if no sponsored).
