

1. Notice.

2. Mr. Pathak Rakesh Kaushik, Advocate accepts notice for the petitioner; Mr. Anil Grover, Advocate accepts notice for the respondent No.2 and Mr. Ruchir Mishra, Advocate accepts notice for the respondent No.3.

3. We have heard learned counsels for the parties orally.

4. It is submitted by the ld. counsel for the applicant-respondent No.4 that given the difficulties expressed by Dr. Nivedita Haran, Returning Officer vide her note dated 29th November, 2017 which was sent through e-mail on the same day to the respondent no.4, the respondent has no objection to the Returning Officer finalizing the list of voters in terms of this Court's order dated 24th November, 2017 or even upon the completion of the verification for holding the election *de novo*. The submission is that the respondent no.4 is only apprehensive that the election process may get delayed or derailed. He prays for time bound directions to the Returning Officer to ensure completion of the election process.

5. It has to be noted that the Returning Officer, vide her note dated 29th November, 2017 had pointed out several difficulties to follow the election schedule and requested the respondent no.4 to seek directions from this Court to commence the election process *de novo*.

This application has, however, been filed after more than a month after 29th November, 2017.

6. We are informed by the ld. counsel for the respondent no.4 that the respondent no.4 has only 74 members.

7. Having regard to the several issues pointed out by the Returning Officer in the note dated 29th November, 2017, we direct that the Returning Officer shall ensure compliance of the directions made by us by our order dated 24th November, 2017 and to

de novo commence the election of the respondent No.4-Judo Federation of India.

8. The respondent no.4 shall ensure that the record sought by the Returning Officer is made available to the Returning Officer within two weeks from today. The Returning Officer would verify the electoral list within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the records.

It is further directed that the election to the Executive Body of the Judo Federation of India shall be held *de novo* by the Returning Officer and completed as expeditiously as possible, in any case within a period of eight weeks thereafter.

This application is disposed of in the above terms.
