
Sir,

**Minutes of meeting held in the chamber of Secretary (Sports) on 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2018 to consider the post-Asian Games ACTC proposal of "Judo Federation of India" (JFI) for the year 2018-19.**

Secretary (Sports) chaired the meeting. From SAI, Spl. DG, Regional Director (TEAMS), Project Officer and others attended. From Federation side, General Secretary, Director (Technical) and Assistant Secretary of the Federation attended. List of those, who were present is placed at "Annexure-I".


2. At the outset, the ACTC Committee was informed that in the earlier meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 it was decided that ACTC proposal of the Judo Federation of India (JFI) would be considered up to Asian Games only with the exception of the Commonwealth Judo Championship, 2018 to be held at Jaipur in Nov., 2018 and one National Championship for juniors to be held in Nov., 2018.

3. Further, the ACTC Committee in the earlier meeting approved a budget of Rs. 3,95,43,650/-for JFI. The Federation's ACTC proposal for the remaining period in 2018-19 after Asian Games, 2018 is now to be considered.

4. Regional Director (TEAMS) gave an overview of the ACTC proposal of JFI for the period up to March, 2019. Thereafter, the Federation made the following observations:-

- Against Rs. 3.95 cr. approved up to Asian Games, 2018 Rs. 3.17 cr. has been already utilized.
- JFI is in need of a Foreign Coach, as there are four medal prospects for Olympics, 2020. Federation may contact Japan Embassy in India for this purpose.
- Federation may invite Ambassador of Japan in India to witness Commonwealth Judo Championship to be held at Jaipur from 06.11.2018 to 11.11.2018.
- The Federation also proposes to start a Judo Academy in Northern part of India.

5. Secretary (Sports) advised the Federation to take assistance from Japanese to support Indian Coaches. Further, he advised that a Foreign Coach especially from Japan may be considered for appointment and Govt. would pay for his salary. He added that a Foreign Coach may be identified as per procedural guidelines and appoint him for the "Khelo India" Academy proposed to be set up at Bhopal. His services could be utilized for elite Judakas also. Out of the four medal prospects for Olympics, 2020 at least get one of them included under TOPS.

  
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6. Thereafter, the ACTC proposal of the Federation was taken up for consideration. Component-wise discussion took place and the following decisions had been taken:-

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

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**III. International competitions to be held in India in which Indian Team will participate:-**

7. The ACTC Committee was informed that expenditure on the above mentioned component had already been approved in the ACTC meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2018. Therefore, the Committee had not considered this component.

**IV. National Championship for Senior, Junior and Sub-junior:-**

8. The Committee was informed that in the last meeting, National Championship for seniors, juniors, sub-juniors and cadets had already been approved. Total grant approved for National Championship was Rs. 22.00 lakh as provided under the Scheme of Assistance to NSFs. Therefore, the ACTC Committee had not considered this component.

**V. Foreign Coaches:-**

9. The Federation proposed one Foreign Coach each for Men and Women. The Committee advised the Federation to have only one Foreign Coach for both Men and Women. Federation would also follow the guidelines prescribed for appointment of a Foreign Coach/Expert. The Committee, therefore, considered that a budget allocation of Rs. 44.40 lakh, proposed by JFI, for this component in 2018-19 is pre-mature. Federation agreed with the suggestion of the ACTC Committee.

**VI. Support Staff:-**

10. Federation proposed the appointment of 1 Physio from SAI to assist the athletes in camps and domestic and international competitions. The Committee approved the proposal and also approved the budget of Rs. 1.80 lakh for the remaining period of six (6) months in 2018-19.

**VII. Sports Equipment:-**

11. The Committee was informed that in the last meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2018, 64 sets of IJF approved Judo dresses had been approved with a budget of Rs. 7.04 lakh. The same requirement has been projected again in the current ACTC proposal. The Committee, therefore, had not considered this item for procurement. The Committee, however, considered the other items like Judo Dummies, Judo Mats etc., and approved a total budget of Rs. 30.80 lakh, as shown under:-

- o Judo Dummies ( 20 Nos ) = **Rs. 0.80 lakh**  
(Light, Medium and Heavy weights practice )
- o CARE System ( for monitoring bouts in details ) - **Rs. 5.00 lakh**
- o JUDO Mats ( 98 Pcs x 2 Sets - IJF approved ) - **Rs. 25.00 lakh**
- Total :- Rs. 30.80 lakh**

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12. The Committee noted that except for procurement of Judo Mats, the estimated expenditure of other individual items like;(i) Judo Dummies (20 nos.); and (ii) CARE System, do not exceed the limit of Rs. 10.00 lakh, prescribed for procurement in the Scheme of the Assistance to NSFs. The Committee, therefore, advised the Federation to procure these items as per Govt. procedures and GFR provisions.

13. In the case of procurement of Judo Mats, which are estimated to cost Rs. 25.00 lakh, SAI would undertake the procurement after the Federation submits specifications, sources of supply etc., (98 pieces X two (2) sets - IJF approved).

14. Thus, the Committee approved a total budget of Rs. 30.80 lakh for procurement of various items including Judo Mats.

15. This way, the total approved budget for Judo Federation of India under ACTC for the remaining period of 2018-19 (after Asian Games, 2018 and up to March, 2019 Rs. 180.60 lakh has shown under:-


(i)	National Coaching Camps for senior (Men and Women)	:- Rs. 76.00 lakh
(ii)	International Competitions/training for seniors (Men and Women)	:- Rs. 72.00 lakh
(iii)	Support staff	:- Rs. 1.80 lakh
(iv)	Sports Equipment	:- Rs. 30.80 lakh


**Total:- Rs. 180.60 lakh**

16. In the ACTC meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 a budget of Rs. 395.44 lakh was approved for JFI up to Asian Games, 2018. With the budget of Rs. 180.60 lakh approved for the period after Asian Games, 2018 and up to March, 2019, the total budget approved under ACTC for the JFI for 2018-19 is Rs. 576.04 lakh.
