## **Scheme of JFI Training Center**

### **BASIC CONCEPT**

The winning of medals by Indian Judo players in the Commonwealth Games, and other International events is a matter of great significance. By accepting this fact, Judo Federation of India (JFI) is planning to set-up JFI Training Centers all over India, which will offer an opportunity to talented Judo players to train under qualified Judo Coaches for long duration in JFI Training Center with modern training facilities.

In the existing sports scenario in India, attention on talented sports persons often gets focused only after he or she has passed young age, and reached, a stage from where no phenomenal growth is possible. The concept of the JFI Centre is to select the best available talents in Judo between 13 – 21 years of age, they can continue training in JFI Training Center upto the age of 25 years, if their performance is good at National and International level.

Keeping these objectives in view JFI Training Centre has been visualised as a co-operative venture between the State Judo Associations, Judo Clubs and Sponsors, from public and private sectors.

### **AIMES & OBEJCTIVES**

- To bring glory to India in the sport of Judo and to inspire the young players to achieve excellence in Sports.
- 2] To provide a vast resource pool of highly skilled sports person a the National Level.
- To ensure that the programme of excellence development is sustained through regular inputs from Sub-Junior and Junior streams.
- To develop awareness regarding the importance the sport of `Judo' for all round development of an Individual and society.
- 5] To obtain medals for India at the International Sports Events.

### **SELECTION OF TALENTS**

To obtain excellence in `Judo' , it is necessary to give training at a proper age under the qualified experts.

# JUDO FEDERATION OF INDIA

At the time of starting the JFI Centre, 25 talented Judokas (men and women) who have played at National / State level Judo Competitions will be selected from the nearby areas of training center, so that they can attend the training sessions on daily basis. In addition to the above 25 Judokas, more players can join the JFI Training Centre, who has played at base level, as practice partners.

JFI will identify One or Two qualified Judo Coaches with good experience in Judo Coaching. The number of Coaches to be involved will depend upon the number of trainees in each category of boys and girls.

### **MONITORING SYSTEM**

In order to monitor the working of the JFI Training Centre, and also the performance of trainees, JFI in consultation with the local Unit/Center officials will appoint governing body, consisting of the following:

By the end of each financial year, the performance of each identified trainee will be assessed and reviewed for better development and results, by JFI in association with the Governing body of each JFI Center.

## SCOPE - REQUIREMENT OF EACH CENTRE

The aim is to establish at least one or One JFI Training Centers in each State within a period of 6 years having the following facilities:

i] Judo Hall 16mtr x 16mtr. (with Judo mats)

ii] Gymnasium Multi gym with separate station with training facilities

iii] Changing room Changing rooms with toilet facilities.

iv] Office : 1 room with basic office facilities ( having Computer

with Internet and T.V, CD Player etc.)

### **ELIGIBILITY**

The JFI Training Centers can be started by the following organisations, sponsors, who are having the above facilities with Judo Hall:

- State Judo Associations
- Non-Government Organizations ( NGO )
- Recognized Schools
- Recognized Clubs

## ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE JFI

- Judo Dresses for best Judo Players
- Direct participation of selected players in State and National Judo Events ( as JFI Training Centre Team )
- Technical Assistance, and special training session by National / International Coaches.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE SPONSOR

- Salary of One Judo Coach (INR.15,000 20,000/- per month)
- Scholarship for talented Judo Players (@ INR1000/- per month)
- Track Suit and Shoes to players (at least once in year)
- Judo Dress (once in a year).

## **ADVANTAGES OF SPONSORS**

- Wide publicity through selected Judo players
- > Sponsors can place banner / hoarding with their official logo in the JFI Training Center
- > Sponsor's logo can be displayed on the Track Suit of Judokas.
