5] Coaching Camp : It is compulsory for those appearing for BB & NDIC to attend the Coaching Camp. The revised syllabus, latest contest techniques ,etc., will be taught at the Coaching Camp. Those Judokas who do not wish to appear for the Exam, but wish to learn new techniques are permitted to join the camp.

6] Examinations: Exam will be conducted for Sho Dan, Ni Dan, San Dan & Yon Dan.

7] Criteria for Black Belt Examination (Sho-Dan / 1st Dan):

- Those appearing for Black Belt (Sho Dan) must be minimum 15 years of age.
- Should have practiced Judo for 7 years.
- An existing Black Belt holder should be one recognized by JFI. The grade awarded by any other institution will not be recognized.
- A candidate appearing for Sho Dan , should have received his/her 1st kyu grade one year prior to this exam.
- Those appearing for Dan Grades must attach the following documents along with the application form:
 - a) Past contest records.
 - b) Photocopies of the certificates of the contests
 - c) Those who do not have certificates should submit teaching experience and contributions made towards promotion of Judo (a brief note)
 - d) Outstanding performance of the players trained by him/her.
- Present grade certificate (photocopy) should be attached.
- The application form must be signed by the President /Secretary / Deptt. Head of the State Association / Deptt. to which the candidate belongs is mandatory.

8] Criteria for Black Belt Examination (Ni-Dan / 2nd Dan):

- Those appearing for Black Belt (Ni-Dan) must be minimum 17 years of age.
- Should have practiced Judo for 9 years.
- An existing Black Belt holder should be one recognized by JFI. The grade awarded by any other institution will not be recognized.

- A candidate appearing for Ni-Dan , should have received his/her Sho-Dan two years prior to this exam.
- Those appearing for Dan Grades must attach the following documents along with the application form:
 - a) Past contest records.
 - b) Photocopies of the certificates of the contests
 - c) Those who do not have certificates should submit teaching experience and contributions made towards promotion of Judo (a brief note)
 - d) Outstanding performance of the players trained by him/her.
- Present grade certificate (photocopy) should be attached.
- The application form must be signed by the President /Secretary / Deptt. Head of the State Association / Deptt. to which the candidate belongs is mandatory.

9] Criteria for Black Belt Examination (San-Dan / 3rd Dan):

- Those appearing for Black Belt (San-Dan) must be minimum 20 years of age.
- Should have practiced Judo for 12 years.
- An existing Black Belt holder should be one recognized by JFI. The grade awarded by any other institution will not be recognized.
- A candidate appearing for San-Dan , should have received his/her Ni-Dan three years prior to this exam.
- Those appearing for Dan Grades must attach the following documents along with the application form:
 - a) Past contest records.
 - b) Photocopies of the certificates of the contests
 - c) Those who do not have certificates should submit teaching experience and contributions made towards promotion of Judo (a brief note)
 - d) Outstanding performance of the players trained by him/her.
- Present grade certificate (photocopy) should be attached.
- The application form must be signed by the President /Secretary / Deptt. Head of the State Association / Deptt. to which the candidate belongs is mandatory.

10] Criteria for Black Belt Examination (Yon-Dan / 4th Dan):

- Those appearing for Black Belt (Yon-Dan) must be minimum 24 years of age.
- Should have practiced Judo for 16 years.
- An existing Black Belt holder should be one recognized by JFI. The grade awarded by any other institution will not be recognized.
- A candidate appearing for Yon-Dan , should have received his/her San-Dan four years prior to this exam.
- Those appearing for Dan Grades must attach the following documents along with the application form:
 - a) Past contest records.
 - b) Photocopies of the certificates of the contests
 - c) Those who do not have certificates should submit teaching experience and contributions made towards promotion of Judo (a brief note)
 - d) Outstanding performance of the players trained by him/her.

- Present grade certificate (photocopy) should be attached.
- The application form must be signed by the President / Secretary / Deptt. Head of the State Association / Deptt. to which the candidate belongs is mandatory.

14] National Diploma In Coaching (NDIC)

JFI is introducing National Diploma in Coaching (NDIC) to educate and grading the Indian Judo Coaches from grass-root level to International level.

This introductory programme of the Diploma Course will definitely helps to promote standard of the Indian Judo Coaches who are working in Government Sectors, Sports Academies, Clubs, Institutions, Colleges, Schools and who wants to become a Judo Coach. This course will also to set up uniformity across India in Judo Training.

As an introductory programme of the NDIC, all the interested Judokas/Coaches falling in the following criteria are requested to attend the NDIC introductory programme for the further gradation in Judo Coaching.

The eligibility criteria and mandatory requirements are as under:

- ❖ NDIC is a post Black Belt Diploma.
- ❖ The minimum qualification is the candidate should be a Ni Dan (2nd Dan) of the JFI.
- ❖ Minimum Age : Men – 20 years ; Women – 18 years.
- ❖ Should have practiced Judo for 10 years.
- ❖ An active Coach at the District & State.
- ❖ An amount of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three thousand only) is to be paid to the Judo Federation of India by Demand Draft / RTGS, as Entry Fee.
- ❖ The NDIC application form (attached) must be signed by the President /Secretary /Deptt. Head of the State Association / Deptt. to which the candidate belongs is mandatory.
- ❖ The application Forms must be received by JFI and the Organisers through email **BEFORE 26th MAY 2019** (late entries , individual's direct entries will not be entertained).
