

**Judo - Minutes of ACTC 2021-22 - 8<sup>th</sup> June 2021: Judo Federation of India (JFI)**

The ACTC meeting was held under the chairmanship of Shri. Ravi Mital, IAS, Secretary (Sports) on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2021 via video conferencing to consider ACTC and budget request for Judo Federation of India (JFI) for the period April 2021 to March 2022. List of members present in the meeting is attached at the end.

2. Judo Federation of India (JFI) enlisted the following milestones and targets for Indian Judoka which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC and budget:



3. The calendar was considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The approved calendar and budget are attached at **Annexure I**.

4. Other salient decisions are as below:

- i. DG SAI was authorized to approve changes in budget arriving out of any alteration in dates/number of athletes in National Coaching Camps and Foreign Exposure (Training and Competition) owing to changes made by International Judo Fédération (IJF).
- ii. Domestic Competition structure would be approved as per current 'Assistance to NSF' norms, i.e. @ Rs. 22 lakh per year for organising Senior, Junior and Sub-Junior National Championships. However, if the norms are revised, the revised norms shall be applicable for conducting the domestic competitions.
- iii. In addition to the above, an amount of **Rs. 9,90,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakh Ninety Thousand Only)** to be booked under **Human Resource Development Scheme (HRDS)**



for Coach/Referee/Technical Official Development Programme. Further, JFI was requested that the Coach Education Programme should be upgraded as per international standards in collaboration with International Judo Federation (IJF). The details are placed at **Annexure II**.

5. Total budget of **Rs. 4,07,93,740/- (Rupees Four Crores Seven Lakhs Ninety-Three Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty only)** was approved for JFI up to March 2022. The breakup of the amount is as follows:
